



Assembly Instruction for 1250ML TYPE OMNI 50

ALUMINUM BOTTLES U.N. APPROVED AS SINGLE PACKAGINGS (1B1).

This bottle has been tested and approved with the following components:

Option 1 : Group I, II, III

1/ ALUMINUM BOTTLE

2/ LDPE PLUG

3/ PP CAP WITH ALPE/PEE LINER

After filling, insert the sealing plug to full depth by pushing it down, screw the cap to the following recommended torque: 89 Inch per lbs.

Recommended Torque Wrench. Item # TORQ009

Custom chuck. Item # ADA500M

Option 2 : Group I, II, III

1/ ALUMINUM BOTTLE

2/ PP CAP WITH PTFE (Teflon) LINER

After filling, screw the cap to the following recommended torque: 62 Inch per lbs.

Recommended Torque Wrench. Item # TORQ009

Custom chuck. Item # ADA500M

Option 3 : Group I, II, III

1/ ALUMINUM BOTTLE

2/ PP CAP WITH ALPE/PEE LINER

After filling, screw the cap to the following recommended torque: 62 Inch per lbs.

Recommended Torque Wrench. Item # TORQ009

Custom chuck. Item # ADA500M

Labeling and marking are the shipper's responsibility.

NON U.N. CLOSURE OPTIONS

Because of the large number of bottles and closure systems and the cost of testing and maintaining certificates, we have certified the most used closures.

A closure that hasn't been tested for the U.N. requirements can be used for nonhazardous products. Even if they have not been tested it doesn't mean that they are inferior in any way. Ask your sales rep if you need to have the below closure system certified.
